

NOTICE OF JUDICIAL VACANCY

**Circuit Court
21st Judicial District
Hickman, Lewis, Perry, and Williamson Counties**

Pursuant to the State of Tennessee Executive Order 34, notice is hereby given that the Governor's Commission for Judicial Appointments will meet on September 30, 2014 in Franklin to initiate the process of filling a vacancy in the District's Circuit Court. The Honorable Timothy Easter has been appointed to the Court of Criminal Appeals by Governor Bill Haslam, thereby creating a vacancy effective September 1, 2014.

Any member of the public, both lay and attorney, shall be entitled to attend the public hearing to express, orally or in writing, such citizen's approval of or objections to any suggested nominee for the judicial vacancy.

Any interested applicant must be an attorney licensed in Tennessee who is at least 30 years of age, a resident of the state for five years, and must reside in the Judicial District. All interested candidates should submit a completed Applicant Questionnaire, available on our website at www.tncourts.gov, to the Commission for its consideration. Questionnaires should be submitted to the Administrative Office of the Courts, Suite 600, Nashville City Center, 511 Union Street, Nashville, TN 37219, by no later than September 16, 2014 at Noon CDT. The Commission encourages all candidates to submit applications as early as possible.

Each candidate must submit the original (unbound) and **eight (8) copies** (stapled or bound and printed on front and back) **as well as a digital copy** of the Applicant Questionnaire in order to have his/her name placed on the list of candidates for the judicial vacancy for which he/she is applying.

The Commission is committed to the goal of a diverse judiciary and encourages all qualified attorneys to apply for any judicial vacancy for consideration without regard to race, ethnicity or gender.
